



**Green Lea First School**

**'Learn, Explore, Achieve'**

**Intent**

At Green Lea, our History curriculum aims to inspire children's learning through exploration in order to know more and remember more about the past. The Green Lea History curriculum, gives children a secure knowledge and understanding of British, Local and World History. Pupils will develop their historical knowledge; skills and historical vocabulary so that they are able to draw comparisons, make connections and demonstrate a secure chronological understanding.

**Implementation**

At Green Lea, we follow the National Curriculum Programmes of Study. Both Key Stage 1 and 2 follow a two year rolling programme to ensure full curriculum coverage. Our History journey starts in the EYFS through Understanding of The World Development which prepares the children for Key Stage One History. In each unit, 'Chronology' is explicitly taught to ensure children can demonstrate a secure chronological understanding. At Green Lea, learning always builds on prior knowledge to support children in making links within and across the periods that they study. Every unit is underpinned by key vocabulary, key concepts, core knowledge and explicit historical skills. We provide regular experiential learning and enriching opportunities such as trips, immersion and visitors to make history learning meaningful.

**Impact**

Children will be increasingly aware of how historical events and people have shaped the world that they live in today. They will become increasingly analytical with their thinking, making informed and balanced judgements based on their knowledge of the past. Children will have a secure understanding of British, Local and World History and have an appreciation for the diversity of the world that we live in.
