This week the Reception Mathematicians have been learning about positional language. They read the story Rosie's Walk and used props to describe the different positions. You can use lots of positional language when drawing pictures e.g. Can you draw a sun above the house, or draw a sheep next to a cow? Have a go this weekend if you get chance. Our Nursery Mathematicians have been learning all about 2. How many lots of two can you find when you are out and about this weekend?

Class 2 (Super Squirrels)

Our Geographers of Class 2 have been learning about the location of the 5 oceans in relation to the 7 continents. Can they practice learning this knowledge with you at home? Why not plan a dream trip and use a map/globe to navigate the way?

Class 3 (Super Seekers)

The Geographers of Class 3 have learned about the location of the Equator, both tropics and the Northern and Southern Hemisphere. They have been developing their map reading skills using atlases. We can't wait to see it when we visit!


This week is Anti-Bullying Week.
