<b>Orchestra</b>	People playing musical instruments together.	<b>Johann Sebastian Bach was a German composer. He wrote Air on a G string in 1831. This was the Baroque period.</b>	
		<b>Maurice Ravel was a French composer. He wrote Bolero in 1928 as a ballet. This was the 20<sup>th</sup> century.</b>
