Beat
The steady pulse you feel in the music like a clock's tick.

Rhythm
The actual sound or time value of the notes which in a song is the same as the words.

Syncopated rhythm
A rhythm that fits between the beats.

Ostinato
A repeating pattern

A minor chord
A - C - E

F major chord
F - A - C
