


Music: Recorder (LKS2)

Staff
A staff (or staff) is a set of five horizontal lines and the spaces between them. A note can be in a space or on a line. Notes with a higher pitch are higher on the staff.


Treble clef staff




Crotchet 1 beat



Quaver 1/2 a beat



Minim 2 beats



Semi breve 4 beats



Concepts are:

Pitch - High or low sounds

Duration - Long or short sounds

Tempo - How fast or slow the music is.

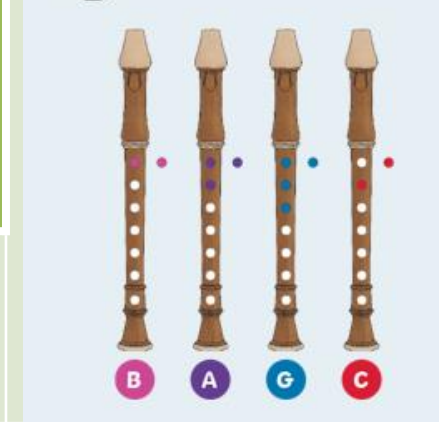
Knowledge - How to play the notes.

Blow into your mouthpiece with slow, steady breaths like cooling off soup!

Play each note with the same even tone.

Take a deep breath with a 'ta' in the mouthpiece when you want to play a few notes in a row.
