Two parts sung or played by different musicians.

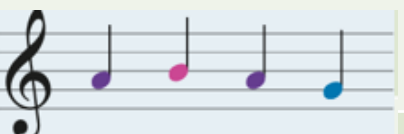
Chord Sequence

Chords that are repeated.

Concepts are:

Pitch - High or low sounds

Duration - How long or short a note is.

Timbre - Describe the sound quality of an instrument: bright, dark.

Structure - Order of parts or sections of music.

An English composer of choral music.



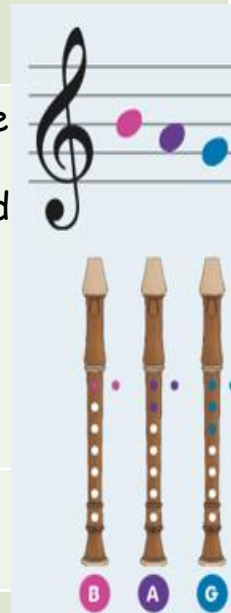
A composer is a person who writes music.
