How you can help your child this term

Try and find regular time to read with your child. Just ten minutes each day will help them to learn new words and become more fluent at reading.

Ask your child questions about the content of their book to check their understanding. Discuss any new vocabulary; use a dictionary.

Can they predict what might happen next or give reasons why a character has behaved in a particular way?

Can they summarise a paragraph, page or chapter?

Practise reading and spelling the high frequency words, which will be sent home.

Try to practise number bonds and times tables regularly.
