This week at Green Lea:

Class 1 (Fantastic Foxes)

The children are busy learning about 'People Who Help Us'. They have focused on going to the doctors and why it is important to keep ourselves healthy. Why not talk about ways to stay healthy over the weekend. We are also keen for visitors to come and talk about their roles so if you are in the medical sector and think you could help do get in touch.

Class 2 (Super Squirrels)
