English

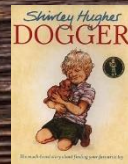
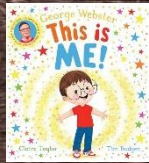
Nursery:

The children will experiment with mark making

Reception:

The children will learn to write their name. They will be introduced to Set 1 of the Read Write Inc phonic scheme and will practice blending and segmenting simple words.

We are reading...



We will be sharing the books: This is me! and Dogger.

The children will practise the reading skills of listening, attention, alliteration and sound discrimination.

Maths

Nursery:

The children will learn number linked nursery rhymes.

Reception:

The children will learn to match, sort and compare. They will be introduced to numbers 1-5 and be exploring shapes.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will explore colour mixing and painting their own self-portraits.

The children will be introduced to a range of media, tools and experiment with different techniques.

The children will listen to music and sing class and school songs.

The children will be introducing to percussion instruments and will investigate pitch tone.

Physical Development

The children will be learning spatial awareness. They will be introduced to ball games and dance.

The children will take part in 'Squiggle While You Wiggle' and 'Squiggle Me Into a Writer', daily.

There will be daily fine motor activities.

Understanding the World

The children will take part in Forest School each week

The children will learn about people in the community who help us and why they are important.

The children will learn about festivals and celebrations, Bonfire Night, Diwali and Christmas.

Communication and Language

The children will be listening to and retelling stories.

They will learn how to sequence a story.

The will learn how to predict what might happen and talk about a new ending to a story.

They will learn how to follow safety instructions in Forest School.
