## Subject Specific Vocabulary

<b>Chronology</b>	The order things/events happen.
<b>BC</b>	This means before the birth of Jesus Christ.
<b>AD</b>	This means Anno Domini which is Latin for 'in the year of our Lord.'
<b>Significance</b>	Something or someone that is an important part of the past.
<b>Cause and consequence</b>	A relationship between an event and the events or results that follow it.
<b>Empire</b>	A group of lands or regions ruled by one single ruler.
<b>Emperor</b>	A ruler having total control of a country or region.
<b>Invasion</b>	The act of using an attack by an army into a country or region.

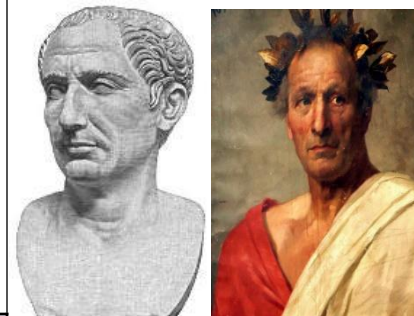


# Knowledge
