AD	This means Anno Domini which is Latin for 'in the year of our Lord.'
Significance	The quality of being important

Anglo Saxons	The Anglo-Saxons were a group of farmer-warriors who lived in Britain thousands of years ago. Made up of three tribes who came over from Germany, Netherlands and Denmark.
Kingdom	A state or government having a king or a queen at its head.
Settlement	A place where people decide to live.

Seven Kingdoms

Britain was split into 7 kingdoms in AD 660: Northumbria, Mercia, East Anglia, Essex, Wessex, Sussex and Kent.
