England is divided up into 'regions' and 'counties'

Counties are the top level of local government controlling the local area and services such as education, transport, policing and fire.

England is divided up into 48 counties.

Counties: Staffordshire, Shropshire, Cheshire, Derbyshire, Leicestershire, Worcestershire, Warwickshire, Cornwall.

Cities: Manchester, London, Liverpool, Edinburgh.
