**Place** What a place is like describing the human and physical features.



**Source** The point at which a river starts.

**Channel** The path of a river.

**Meander** The natural bend in a river.

**Transportation** When eroded material is taken downstream.

**Delta** Found in the mouth of large rivers.

**Oxbow lake** A section that dries out because it becomes isolated from the main river.

**Knowledge**  
A river is a flowing, moving stream of water. The River Trent runs through the market town of Stone.

A river flows downwards from high ground to the sea and has the power to erode and shape the landscape. It has an upper, middle and lower course.

Rivers play an important part in the water cycle.
