


Art: Vincent Van Gogh KS1 Knowledge Mat



Subject Specific Vocabulary

Artist	A person who creates paintings and drawings as a hobby or as a profession.
Colour 	There are three primary colours red, blue and yellow. They can be used to mix secondary colours: green, purple and orange.
Line	Short or continuous marks made using a variety of tools. They can be straight, broken, curved or continuous, thick or thin.
Collage	A collage is where you layer and organise different materials by tearing and cutting.

Knowledge

- Vincent Van Gogh (1853 – 1890) was a Dutch painter who came from a small village in Holland. He moved to France where he painted with bright colours.
- He used colour to show feelings.
- He often felt very sad and his art work showed this. He died at the age of 37.
- He made oil paintings with bold, bright colours and used expressive brush strokes.
- The three primary colours of red, blue and yellow can be used to mix the secondary colours of green, purple and orange.
