



Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 2: Spring 2



Target: I know the multiplication and division facts for the 5 times tables

By the end of this half term, children in year 2 should know the following facts and be able to recall them instantly:

X5	÷5
$1 \times 5 = 5$	$5 \div 5 = 1$
$2 \times 5 = 10$	$10 \div 5 = 2$
$3 \times 5 = 15$	$15 \div 5 = 3$
$4 \times 5 = 20$	$20 \div 5 = 4$
$5 \times 5 = 25$	$25 \div 5 = 5$
$6 \times 5 = 30$	$30 \div 5 = 6$
$7 \times 5 = 35$	$35 \div 5 = 7$
$8 \times 5 = 40$	$40 \div 5 = 8$
$9 \times 5 = 45$	$45 \div 5 = 9$
$10 \times 5 = 50$	$50 \div 5 = 10$
$11 \times 5 = 55$	$55 \div 5 = 11$
$12 \times 5 = 60$	$60 \div 5 = 12$

Use what you already know - If your child knows that $5 \times 5 = 25$, they can use this fact to work out that $6 \times 5 = 30$

Test the Parent - Your child can make up their own tricky division questions for you e.g. What is 60 divided by 5? They need to be able to multiply to create these questions.
