**This week at Green Lea:**

**Class 1**

This week in Class it has been out of this world! We've read a story called 'Here Come the Aliens' which was quite funny. This has inspired us to create our own aliens and give them funny names using our phonics sounds. We have been talking about space and looking at rockets and satellites. We wondered what it would be like to be an astronaut. In Maths we have been adding numbers to 20 by counting on from the biggest number and even using a number line to help.

**Class 2**

The Outstanding Owls have all finished writing their stories about the alien that came home to Earth with Bob. They have used some ambitious vocabulary and appropriate grammar to write some super adventures. In maths we are learning the properties of 3D shapes. **Class 3**

In Maths we have started learning about Statistics. The Year Three children have created a pictogram and a bar chart. The Year Four children have compared, found the difference and the total of data from both pictograms and bar charts. 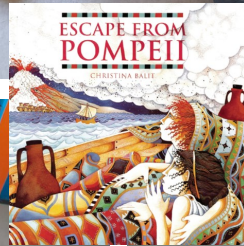
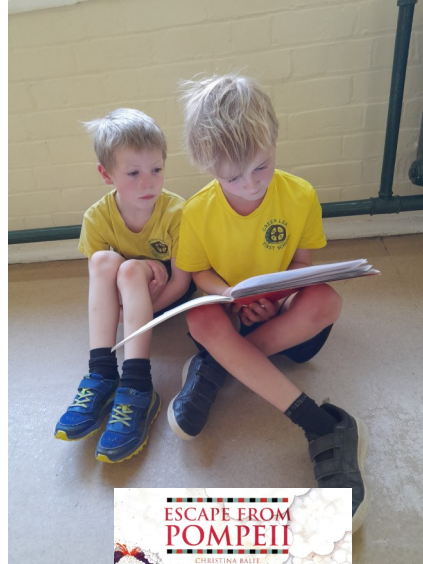

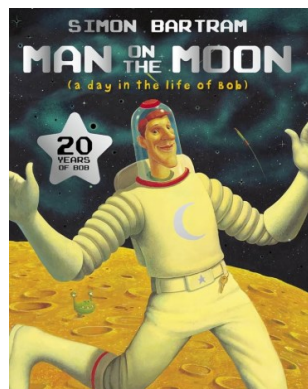


# 'Learn, Explore, Achieve'
