This week at Green Lea:

Class 1

In Class 1 this week we have been working out who the 'Leaf Thief' is and where all the leaves from the trees are going. We have loved sharing this book and found the squirrel and the bird very funny. We've found lots of different leaves - big ones , small ones, red, brown and orange ones, we even found a star shaped one. In Maths we have started to explore numbers—and have looked at making them in different ways and being able to quickly spot them. What numbers can you see when you are out and about? Take a picture and send it to Mrs Compton for our number display.

Class 2

What a super day 'The Determined Deers' have had at Ford Green Hall. Their behaviour was brilliant and they were a credit to the school. This trip has really been a great start to our History block of learning about The Great Fire of London. In Maths the Year Two's have been finding all the fact families and the Year One's have been adding using the part, part whole model. In English we have been finding and writing different sentence starters to make our writing more interesting.

Class 3

In Maths, the Year Three children have been counting in 50s using 3 digit numbers and have been adding 100 more and finding 100 less. The Year Four children have been learning about Roman Numerals and rounding to the nearest 1,000. All children have begun adding practically too. In English, the children have learnt what a monologue is and have empathised with The Iron Man and his feelings whilst he was trapped in a pit. They are excited to start their writing! In History, the children have been looking at what chronology means by creating a timeline of their significant events.
