**Class 1**

In Class One this week we have joined in with world Nursery Rhyme week. It has been lots of fun listening to the different nursery rhymes and completing activities based on them. 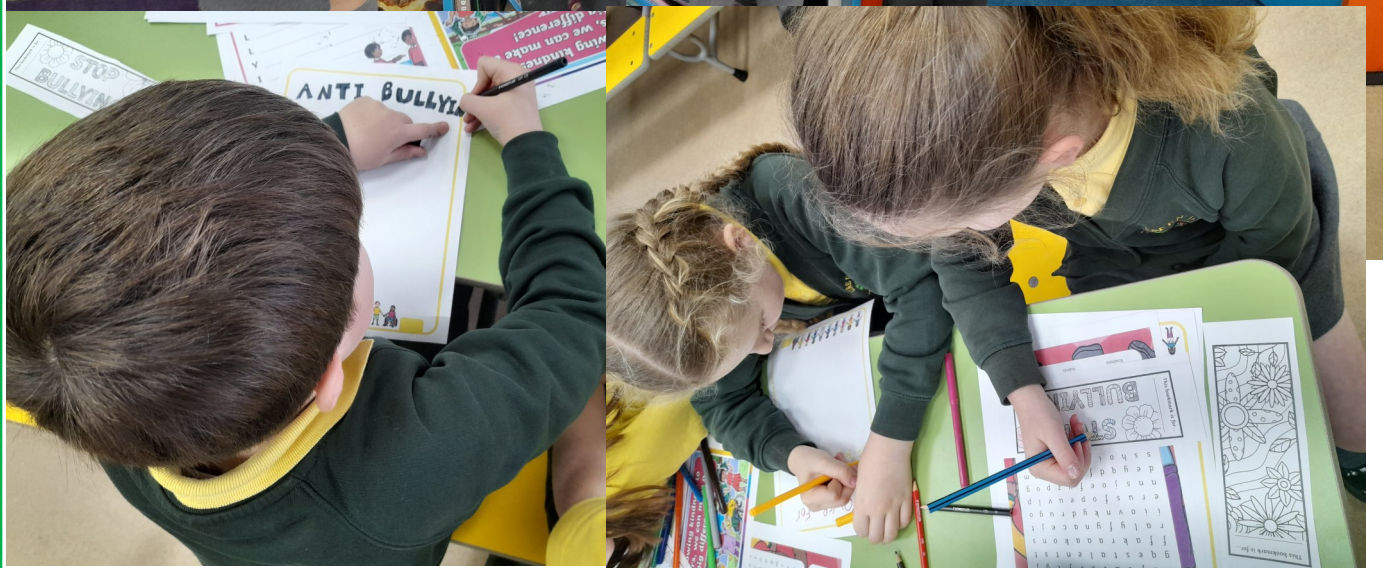

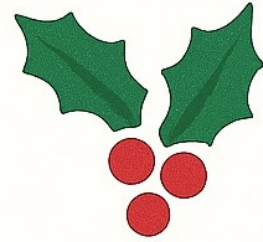
