

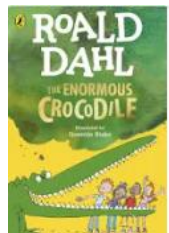


Spring Term in Class 2

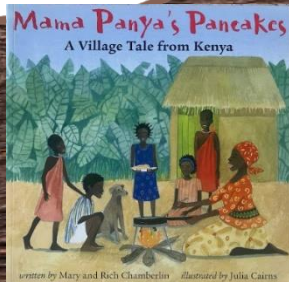
English

The children will have a variety of writing opportunities this Spring term using our text, *The Enormous Crocodile*. They will create a story with repetitive structures, a Non-chronological report, a setting description and a poetry riddle.

The children will also use the text *Mama Panya's Pancakes*.

The children will read daily in small groups to develop fluency and embed their phonics knowledge.

Maths

Year One:

The children will be learning place value within 20. Understanding all the teen numbers.

Year Two:

The children will learn to multiply and divide by 2, 5 and 10.

Art

The children will learn about the artist Pieter Brugel. The children will learn what happens when they draw with hard and soft pencils. The children will learn about Brugel's painting 'Children's Games' and why this was significant. The children will learn to use clay and make their own clay tile concentrating on shape and texture.

Science

This term children in Class 2, will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be identifying plants and their basic parts.

We will also be learning about plants and animals where we live.

History/Geography

History: Queen Victoria

The children will learn about the reign of Queen Victoria and the effect she made on education.

They will learn the chronology of her reign and how it fits with pre-learnt historical events.

Geography:

The children will learn about the weather and the different temperatures across the world.

RE

Celebrations:

We are learning about different celebrations. We will start by learning about Christian and then Muslim celebrations.

We will listen to and ask questions about stories of individuals, special people and those who have a relationship with God.

Music

Through the song 'Football' the children will learn to compose melodies and recognise the difference between pitched and unpitched.

They will learn to chant together rhythmically, marking rests accurately, sing an echo song while tapping the beat, and clap the rhythm of the words understanding there is one beat for each syllable and play a simple ostinato on untuned percussion.

PSHCE

The children will be learning about valuing differences, respecting others and respecting ourselves. They will also look at how to be the best they can be.

Computing

The children will be exploring Purple Mash our computing platform and learning how to stay safe on line.

They will be learning about technology outside of the school.

Using the programs 2DIY and 2PaintA Picture, they will learn to group, sort and create pictures.

DT/PE

Design and Technology:

The children will learn about food and nutrition.

Physical Education:

The children will be learning how to develop strength, flexibility, technique, control and balance in gymnastics.

The children will also be practising their swimming skills.
