This week at Green Lea:

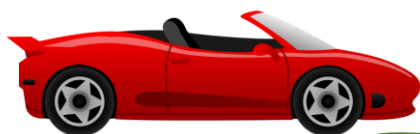
Class 1: In Class 1 we have travelled to the planet Zum-Zee in our book this week and had a very strange tea party! We've been talking all about aliens - making them and drawing them, thinking about what they'd say! We also enjoyed showing our Dads all around our classroom and spending some time being creative with them - thanks for coming Dads! The Reception children have been doubling numbers - see how many doubles we know!

Class 2: The Determined Deers have been learning all about time in Maths this week. Year Two have learnt o'clock, half past, quarter to and past and 5 minutes to and past. Year One have been learning the Days of the Week and the Months of the Year. In English, we have started to read 'The Mousehole Cat' which is a story about a cat that lives with a fisherman in Cornwall. We have made a clay cat and are now writing a repeating poem all about the cat. The scientists of Class Two have been looking at the characteristics of different animals and grouping them.

Class 3: In Class 3, we have been learning about the time. Year Three have been telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes and Year Four have been looking at digital and analogue clocks and converting time between both.
